At the end of 2022 we reported **157 members in 68 families.** As of now, we have **176 members in 72 families**. We also currently have **17 seekers and catechumens.** The official numbers represent a **net gain of 19 members**...another large gain (82 in the last 3 years)!

In addition to Saturday evening and Sunday morning, we celebrate the Paraklesis almost every Wednesday night and often one or two daily and Saturday Liturgies, sometimes more. We continue to have an active seeker class (currently twice per week). Also, I am so pleased to report that we also have a regular church school for all grades...currently on Sundays. We have also revived the Reading Group and added a monthly study for the men of the parish.

GENERAL:

The new addition is now complete and we can use it fully! The back porch/deck should be completed during the month of December and then we can move on to other things besides building!!!

MISSION, COMMUNITY AND CHARITY:
