## **CENSUS:**

At the end of 2023 we reported **176 members in 72 families.** As of now, we have **197 members in 79 families**. We also currently have about **23 seekers and catechumens.** The official numbers represent a **net gain of 21 members** (not including the 14 to be brought in by the end of the year)!

## LITURGICAL LIFE:

In addition to Saturday evening and Sunday morning, we celebrate the Paraklesis almost every Wednesday night and often one or two daily and Saturday Liturgies, sometimes more. Many thanks to our three deacons (Metropolitan SABA ordained Deacon Joseph here back in February...Axios!) and 2 subdeacons, as well as our 4 readers, our choir director and lead chanter...such blessings. Thank God for a vibrant liturgical life.

## **EDUCATION:**

We continue to have an active seeker class (as evidenced by the numbers above). The church school continues on Sundays thanks to our dedicated teachers. I have also begun a weekday class for the elementary ages...mostly on Wednesdays. The Reading Group is working through "Experiences During the Divine Liturgy" on Monday evenings. The men gather monthly for teaching and now the women will also be gathering during the Nativity Fast for teaching as well...Glory to God. Thank you to Alexandra Kerns for organizing and facilitating the teen group...activities and teaching abound there as well.

## MISSION, COMMUNITY AND CHARITY:
